Wayne Nygren is President and Chief Executive Officer of Credit Union Central of British Columbia, the central banking and service facility for the province=s credit union system.

A native of Yorkton, Saskatchewan, he studied economics and finance at the University of Calgary and Carleton University before joining the Bank of Canada in Ottawa as an economist.

Mr. Nygren has held management positions with the Royal Bank of Canada and Credit Union Central of Saskatchewan. In 1981 he became Vice-President and Chief Financial Officer of Central. He assumed his current position in 1985.

He has served as a Director of numerous business and sporting organizations and non-profit associations. He is currently a Director of Credit Union Central of Canada, a Director of the Canadian Payments Association, a Governor of the Council for Canadian Unity, a Governor of Trinity Western University, a Trustee of the B.C.
